



GUARDIANS AND MINORS

All minors (anyone under 18 years of age) must attend Lark Camp with a parent or guardian (a guardian must be at least 21 years of age). There is special paperwork required for a minor to attend with a guardian rather than a parent or legal guardian. Guardians will receive forms that must be filled out by the parent, guardian and minor, and returned to Lark Camp by July 1, or the minor's registration will be canceled with no refund.



TRANSPORTATION

The Woodlands will provide a bus for transportation between camps. The bus operates from 8:00 am to 3:00 am. The bus has been nicknamed Camp Four and can be an on-going portable party and session. Bicycling between camps is encouraged, bring bicycles. Driving between camps is not permitted. If anyone has to make frequent trips to town they will be parked in an area that does not require driving through camp.

PARKING AND CARPOOLING

To keep the number of cars in camp to a minimum, no cars will be allowed in a possible camping space. This means if you are not staying in your vehicle it must go to long term parking. Long term parking is in Camp Three, 1-1/4 miles from the center of Camp One and 1/2 mile from Camp Two; a shuttle bus runs between camps. There is also a parking fee per vehicle: \$50 Discount Price / \$52 Full Price pre-purchase, \$60 if purchased at camp (cash or check only at camp). If you pre-purchase a parking pass and then do not bring a vehicle, contact us after camp for a refund. A vehicle with trailer is considered 2 vehicles. Carpooling is highly encouraged. If you can offer or need a ride post it here. larkcamp.com/carpool.html


